

# 2017 Toyota Eco Youth School (Best Website Category)

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### GENERAL

1. The Toyota Eco Youth is an annual national level environmental education programme organised by UMW Toyota Motor Sdn Bhd (hereinafter referred to as the 'Organiser') with the collaboration of the Ministry of Education, Malaysia.
2. A total of 12 schools participate in this program showcasing projects which benefit the community and environment through their school blog updates.
3. The overall scoring comprises of each of the components below that bring the total scoring to 100%.

- Onsite Judging	- 40%
- Presentation	- 20%
- Exhibition	- 20%
- Website	- 20%
4. The public voting period for the best school blog for the Toyota Eco Youth will run for a total of fourteen (12) days from Monday 4<sup>Th</sup> September 12:00pm to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 12:00pm.

### ELIGIBILITY

1. Voting is open to all Malaysian citizens and residents aged 13 years and above.
2. Voters must have a valid Facebook account.
3. Each voter is eligible to vote one time ONLY for each school.

### PUBLIC VOTING MECHANICS

1. Visit the individual school blogs.
2. Click 'Vote this school' and the voting button will slide out.
3. Click 'Like' to place a vote for that school.
4. Log in to your Facebook account in order to successfully cast a vote for your favourite schools.

## **PUBLIC VOTE SCORES**

1. The total number of 'Likes' will be translated into the score for the 'Best Website - Public Votes' portion.
2. The team with the highest combined scores under the category of Website for 'Public Votes' & 'Judges Evaluation' will win the 'Best Website' award.
3. The organiser reserves the right to withhold details of the scores and mechanics.

## **TERMS**
