TERMS & CONDITIONS

General

1. The Toyota Eco Youth program is organised by UMW Toyota Motor Sdn Bhd (hereinafter referred to as the 'Organiser').
2. A total of 14 schools will participate in this program showcasing projects which benefit the community and environment through blog updates.
3. Members of the public will determine the best project and blog through votes (10%) and the balance of the scoring will be evaluated based on;
 - Best Overall (on-site presentation, exhibition, website) - 40%
 - Best Presentation – 20%
 - Best Website – 20%
 - Best Exhibition – 20%
4. The voting period for the best school blog for the Toyota Eco Youth will run for a total of fourteen (12) days from Monday 12th September 1:00am and ends on Friday 23rd September 2016, 5.30pm.

Eligibility

1. Voting is open to all Malaysian citizens and residents aged 13 years and above. Those below 12 years of age will need the consent of parents/ legal guardian.
2. Voters must have a Facebook account in order to 'like' the school blog.
3. Each voter is eligible to vote once (1) per school only.

How to vote?

1. Visit the school blog
2. Hit the 'like' button at the top left tab – "Vote My School"
3. Log in to your Facebook Account in order to successfully cast your vote(s)

Terms

1. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Terms and Conditions without giving prior notice to any party.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to amend these rules or terminate voting at any time at its sole and absolute discretion. All decisions made by the Organiser under these rules shall be final and no discussion or correspondence will be entertained. The Organiser may, but is not required to, justify any decisions. Legitimate votes will be determined by Toyota Malaysia.
